## **TSCA Declaration of Conformity**



Information on the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), which allows the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to restrict the use of substances.

The Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act, enacted on June 22, 2016, includes a provision in TSCA Section 6(h) that requires the U.S. EPA to take accelerated action on certain persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic (PBT) chemicals to reduce associated risks and exposure to the maximum extent practicable. On January 6, 2021, EPA, which is considered the equivalent of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), issued final regulations to reduce exposure to the PBT chemicals listed below. The regulations became legally effective as early as March 2021.
