

Statement on the Cyber Resilience Act (CRA)

We are aware of the importance of the Cyber Resilience Act (CRA) and the related requirements concerning the cybersecurity of products. The CRA will apply to all products with digital elements – including standalone software – that are placed on the market from December 11, 2027, onwards.

Regardless of this timeline, we are already taking the CRA requirements into account in the development of new products and software solutions. Our goal is to integrate future regulatory expectations into our development and quality processes at an early stage, thereby further strengthening the security and reliability of our products.

Furthermore, we are currently working on a systematic assessment of our existing product and software portfolio to analyse the extent to which adjustments might be necessary. This assessment forms the basis for potential technical or organizational measures to ensure that our products and software continue to meet applicable legal and security requirements in the long term.

In order to comply fully with our reporting obligation under Regulation (EU) 2024/2847, Article 14, we have established a central reporting point as of 28 August 2026, enabling users of our products to report potential vulnerabilities in our products with digital elements, along with information relating to such vulnerabilities. We would like to point out that this is a voluntary extension that goes beyond the legal requirements. We will provide this information in the interest of maximum transparency.

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
