

California Proposition 65



The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 is an initiative of the State of California to address the growing concern about exposure to harmful chemicals. It is intended to ensure that no person, in the course of his or her business activities, knowingly and intentionally exposes an individual to chemicals known to the State of California to be carcinogenic or toxic to reproduction without first providing that individual with a clear and proportionate warning.

To implement the law, the State of California has published, among other things, a list of chemicals suspected of being carcinogenic or toxic to reproduction. The list currently contains more than 800 chemicals. Our products may contain listed substances, but below a level of 0.1%. In addition, no substance should be released from the products you purchase under normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use. However, the sale and use of the named substances or of products containing these substances is not prohibited by California Proposition 65. We would like to point out that you as a purchaser of our products may be subject to further obligations as a result of their use.
